### NOTICE OF AGENCY CONSOLIDATION AND NAME CHANGE

Last year, the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) approved a reorganization of County Sanitation Services. The effect of the reorganization was to consolidate all previously separate sanitation and sewer maintenance districts into one. Accordingly, the following districts have been dissolved and do not exist as legal entities:

Alpine Sanitation District  
Julian Sanitation District  
Lakeside Sanitation District  
Pine Valley Sanitation District  
Spring Valley Sanitation District  
Campo Sewer Maintenance District  
East Otay Mesa Sewer Maintenance District  
Harmony Grove Sewer Maintenance District  
Winter Gardens Sewer Maintenance District

Effective July 1, 2011, the newly formed San Diego County Sanitation District is successor to all assets, contractual rights and obligations, and all other aspects of the previous districts.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the San Diego County Sanitation District has assumed responsibility for the following agreements with the City of San Diego:

#### Transportation

- Agreement between Spring Valley Sanitation District and City of San Diego for Spring Valley Sanitation District Outfall Sewer (dated April 11, 1962).
- Agreement between the City of El Cajon, the City of San Diego, Lakeside Sanitation District, and Alpine Sanitation District and the Santee County Water District for the Construction, Operation and Use of Certain Sewer Facilities (dated July 21, 1975).
- Sewage Transportation Agreement between the City of San Diego and the East Otay Mesa Sewer Maintenance District (dated September 10, 2001).

#### Disposal

- Regional Wastewater Disposal Agreement between the City of San Diego and the Participating Agencies in the Metropolitan Sewerage System.  
**Note** - Participating agencies included the following County districts which existed prior to July 1, 2011: Alpine, Lakeside, and Spring Valley Sanitation Districts; East Otay Mesa, and Winter Gardens Sewer Maintenance Districts.

#### Pretreatment

- Inter-jurisdictional Pretreatment Agreement between City of San Diego and Alpine Sanitation District (dated June 11, 1991).
- Inter-jurisdictional Pretreatment Agreement between City of San Diego and Lakeside Sanitation District (dated June 11, 1991).
- Inter-jurisdictional Pretreatment Agreement between City of San Diego and Spring Valley Sanitation District (dated June 11, 1991).
- Inter-jurisdictional Pretreatment Agreement between City of San Diego and Winter Gardens Sewer Maintenance District (dated June 11, 1991).


The San Diego County Sanitation District will be managing the former sanitation and sewer maintenance districts as "sewer service areas". For example, the former Alpine Sanitation District will now be administratively managed as the Alpine Service Area.

In light of the consolidation of former County districts, it is requested that contract capacities in the metropolitan sewerage system for each of the former County districts – as provided in the Regional Wastewater Disposal Agreement Between the City of San Diego and the Participating Agencies in the Metropolitan Sewerage System (as amended) - be consolidated and the agreement amended to specify a contract capacity of 17.503 million gallons per day for the San Diego County Sanitation District.
