

HOW DO I FILE A FORM 700

When serving on the Metro Wastewater JPA/Commission, you will file a Form 700 - Statement of Economic Interest just like you file when you were Elected to your Agency position. Our new Conflict of Interest Code now also requires Consultants to file as well, (Attorney, Engineer, Treasurer and Executive Director). All Directors and Alternates, as well as the Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer and Executive Director for the Metro Wastewater JPA/Metro Commission and SAN District (if you serve on this also), will file with the Fair Political Practices Commission, using their newly installed computer filing system. They will send you log in information. The remaining filers will continue to file with the County of San Diego.

Those who will need to also file for SAN District are the PAs (Primary and Alternate) from: Coronado, Del Mar, Imperial Beach, Lemon Grove Sanitation District, National City, Otay Water District, Padre Dam, Poway.

Once you are appointed to the JPA/Commission, or hired to one of the positions listed in our new code, the Board Secretary will notify the FPPC and you should receive a letter from the Fair Political Practices Commission or San Diego County, Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Form 700 Filing Clerks advising you that you are receiving their letter because you are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests with them.

The letter will list your position with us and sometimes along with any other committees that also file for in their system (this could be another Board or Commission or the City you represent), along with a date to file by to avoid any penalty.

There will also be a link to their system and normally you will be told to use your email to log in and then set your own password.
